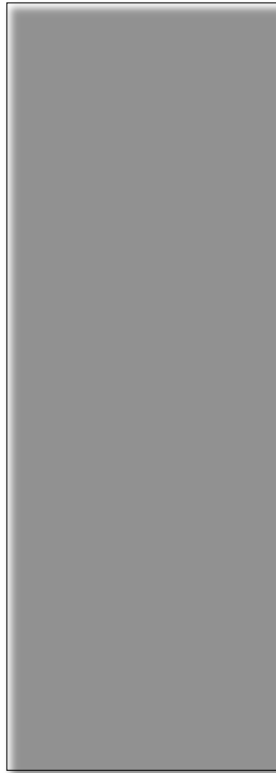


NASH, George Henry (John on Honour Roll)

Place of Birth: Isisford, Queensland

Date of Birth: 15 August 1895

Enlisted at Brisbane, Qld, on 19 July 1917, aged 21 years 11 months.

Next-of-kin was father, John Albert Nash, Ideal Billiard Palace, Stanley Street, South Brisbane, Queensland. (Mother: Sarah Ann Nash, nee Last)

On enlistment he was 5 feet 7 inches and weighed 130 lbs. His chest measurement was 32-36 inches. His occupation was engineer. Unit embarked from Sydney, New South Wales, on board HMAT A14 *Euripides* on 31 October 1917. Served in France. Died of wounds at Collecting Post of 13th Australian Field Ambulance. 4 July 1918. Buried Crucifix Corner Cemetery (Plot X, Row B, Grave No. 7), Villers-Brettoneux, France.
