

Wounded second occasion in France 22 October 1917. Transferred to England ex 7th Can General Hospital Etaples. Admitted Horton County London War Hospital Epsom England 28 October 1917 GSW left arm left leg severe.

Returned to Australia 1 May 1919. Discharged
