On enlistment he was 5 ft 7.5 inches and weighed 138 lbs. His chest measurement was 33-37 inches. His occupation was farmer, Bracewell, Mount Larcom, Queensland. Unit embarked from Sydney, New South Wales, on board HMAT A23 *Suffolk* on 30 November 1915. Served Egypt, Western Front. Returned to Australia 8 September 1919. Discharged 30 December 1919. Died 12 August 1959.
