Enlisted at Rockhampton, Qld, on 25 September 1915 aged 23 years 4 months. Next-of-kin was mother, Jane Pitts, Cheriton Bishop, Exeter, Devonshire, England (Parents: John and Jane Pitts, Honeyford, Cheriton Bishop, Devon).

On enlistment he was 5 feet 6.5 inches and weighed 10 stone 10 lbs. His chest measurement was 39 inches. His occupation was farming. Served on Western Front. Suffered from mumps from 17 January 1917 to 7 February 1917. Rejoined unit 11 February 1917. Killed in action 15 April 1917. Buried Berks Cemetery Extension (Row G, Grave no. 25), Ploegsteert, Belgium.
