Enlisted at Bundaberg Qld, on 23 October 1916 aged 19 years 10 months.

Next-of-kin was mother, Mrs Mary Pomfret, Curtis Street, South Bundaberg, Qld.

On enlistment he was 5 ft 6 inches and weighed 154 lbs. His chest measurement was 35-38.25 inches. His occupation was carpenter, Curtis Street, South Bundaberg, Queensland. Previous service 4<sup>th</sup> Infantry militia 2 years. Unit embarked from Sydney, NSW, on board HMAT A64 *Demosthenes* 22 December 1916. Served France. Detached to 4<sup>th</sup> Canadian Tunnelling Company as miner 11 January 1918. Rejoined Battalion. Wounded in action France 5 April 1918 GSW Forearm. To hospital. Rejoined battalion 13 October 1918. Returned to Australia 23 June 1919.
