Enlisted at: Hughenden, Queensland on 17 January 1915, aged 31 years 10 months.

Next-of-kin was his sister, Mrs (Grace) Irene Power, Valley Gladstone, Qld.

On enlistment he was 5 ft 4.5 inches and weighed 9 stone 2 lbs. His chest measurement was 33-35.5 inches. His occupation was stockman. Address c/- Gladstone Post Office, Gladstone, Qld. Unit embarked from Newcastle, New South Wales, on board HMAT A57 *Malakuta* on 17 May 1915. Taken on strength from 25 September 1915 Gallipoli. Sick to hospital bronchitis 5 January 1916. Rejoined unit 14 January 1916. Proceeded to France 30 June 1916. Bronchitis 11 October 1916. To hospital 26 October 1916. Rejoined from hospital. Returned to Australia 21 March 1919.
