Proceeded overseas to France 23 April 1917. Transferred to 3rd Machine Gun Battalion 28 April 1918. To hospital sick 27 September 1918. Rejoined unit 16 October 1918. Detached to Australian Base Depots for duty Have 17 February 1919. Returned to Australia 22 July 1919.
