Enlisted at Brisbane, Qld, on 10 June 1915, aged 39 years 3 months.

Next-of-kin was brother, William Robertson, Calliope Station, Gladstone, Qld.

On enlistment he was 5 ft 8 inches and weighed 129 lbs. His chest measurement was 34-35 inches. His occupation was miner. Unit embarked from Sydney, NSW on board HMAT A33 *Ayrshire* on 1 September 1915. Served Egypt. Admitted hospital fibrositis (spine) 30 April 1916. 4 June 1916 left Alexandria for Marseilles, disembarking 11 June 1916. Wounded in action shell wound right thigh 24 June 1916. Transferred to England from Boulogne. Discharged from hospital 1 Sep 1916. Marched in 2 Sep 1916. Served France. Returned to Australia 15 February 1918.
