Enlisted at: Rockhampton, Queensland on 5 January 1916, aged 31 years 3 months.

Next-of-kin was sister, Mrs Polly Cox, Long Gully, Mount Morgan, Queensland. His mother was named as Mrs C Sharland, 55 Overstone Road, Hammersmith, London.

On enlistment he was 5 feet 11 inches and weighed 10 stone. His chest measurement was 34.5 inches. His occupation was miner. Unit embarked from Adelaide, South Australia, on board HMAT A29 *Suevic* on 31 May 1916. Served Western Front. Proceeded overseas 16 August 1916. Admitted hospital France 13 July 1918, sick bronchitis. Discharged from hospital 26 August 1918, then to Australian General Base Depot Sick. Rejoined unit 2 September 1918. Admitted 13th Field Ambulance hospital 15 February 1919. Influenza. Discharged in London 4 March 1919 medically unfit.
