Enlisted at: Gladstone, Qld, on 8 March 1915, aged 30 years 2 months.

Next-of-kin was mother, Mrs M.A. Sheridan, St George, Qld.

On enlistment he was 5 ft 7 inches and weighed 128 lbs. His chest measurement was 33-35 inches. His occupation was labourer. Unit embarked from Brisbane, Queensland, on board HMAT A60 *Aeneas* on 29 June 1915. Admitted 2nd Australian General Hospital *Ghezireh* GSW Right hip. Rejoined battalion. France: GSW left shoulder and hand on 5 August 1916. Embarked at Southampton per No. 1 Australian Hospital ship to Melbourne 16 October 1916. Discharged 7 March 1917. Died 24 September 1939.
