Enlisted at Rockhampton, Qld, on 21 September 1915, aged 22 years 9 months.

Next-of-kin was mother, Mrs Charlotte Small, Calliope, via Gladstone, Qld

On enlistment he was 5 feet 6.5 inches and weighed 9 stone 9 lbs. His chest measurement was 35.5 inches. His occupation was labourer. Unit embarked from Brisbane, Queensland, on board HMAT A62 *Wandilla* on 31 January 1916. 2 March 1916. Served in Mediterranean Expeditionary Forces. Sick to Hospital, Heliopolis Mumps 27 March 1916. Returned to duty 3 April 1916. Transferred to 119<sup>th</sup> Howitzer Battery, Boyton 16 October 1916. Driver. Proceeded overseas to France via Southampton 26 March 1917. Served Belgium and France. Returned 12 May 1919. Discharged. Married Frances Elsie May (May) Shapland. Died 4 April 1955. Buried Calliope Cemetery, Calliope, Queensland.
