Enlisted at: Rockhampton, Qld on 15 February 1916, aged 33 years 4 months.

Next-of-kin was wife, Eliza Ann Spencer, Central Lane, Gladstone, Qld.

On enlistment he was 5 ft 7.5 inches and weighed 10 stone 0 lbs. His chest measurement was 35.75 inches. His occupation was labourer. Unit embarked from Brisbane, Queensland, on board HMAT A46 *Clan Macgillivray* on 1 May 1916. Served France. To Hospital with septic toe. Then sick. 19 January 1917. To hospital sick 31 May 1917. Nephritis. Returned to Australia 10 September 1917. Discharged 15 December 1917.
