

## St LEDGER, Francis (Dominic)

Date of Birth: 1 May 1885

Enlisted at Rockhampton, Queensland, on 29 July 1916 aged 31 years 3 months.

Next-of-kin was sister, Mrs Theresa Micock, Queens Street, Maryborough, Queensland.

On enlistment he was 5 ft 3 inches and weighed 8 stone 1 lbs. His chest measurement was 34.25 inches. His occupation was jockey. Unit embarked from Brisbane, Queensland, on board HMAT A55 *Kyarra* on 17 November 1916. Served in France. Sick to hospital with trench fever 22 August 1917. Transferred to Edmonton Military Hospital, England 26 August 1917. Discharged as medically unfit on 12 May 1918. Returned to Australia 12 May 1918. Premature senility.

Died Maryborough, Qld, 5 May 1946, aged 61 years. Buried Maryborough Lawn Cemetery, Qld. Monumental N Plot 332/13.
