

## STREETER, William Frederick Timson

Date of Birth: 8 June 1891

Enlisted at: Brisbane, Qld, on 23 March 1916, aged 25 years 8 months. Next-of-kin was father, William Streeter, Colosseum, North Coast Line, Queensland.

On enlistment he was 5 ft 6.5 inches and weighed 135 lbs. His chest measurement was 36-38 inches. His occupation was labourer, Colosseum, NC Line, Queensland. Unit embarked from Brisbane, Queensland, on board HMAT A42 *Boorara* on 16 August 1916. Proceeded overseas to France 28 December 1916. Admitted to hospital England 21 January 1917 with pneumonia. Suffered various bouts of illness, plus had an accidental fall from a window in January 1919. Returned to Australia 19 April 1919. Died 7 January 1922, aged 85 years. Buried Bundaberg General Cemetery, Queensland.
