Enlisted at Rockhampton, on 15 February 1916, aged 20 years 7 months.

Next-of-kin was his father, George Welch of 'Bayou', Calliope, Qld.

On enlistment he was 5 feet 6 inches and weighed 8 stone 9 lbs. His chest measurement was 33.5 inches. His occupation was selector. He served in France on the Somme and suffered from three bouts of illness. Killed in action at Cerisy Gailly, Somme, France aged 23 years on 8 August 1918. His first cousin, Robert James Welch, 49th Battalion was killed on the Somme on 9 August 1918. Cecil is commemorated at Heath Cemetery, Harbonnieres, (IV. J. 13.), France.
