On enlistment he was 5 ft 7.5 inches and weighed 11 stone 2 lbs. His chest measurement was 36-37.5 inches. His occupation was labourer, Many Peaks, Qld. Unit embarked from Brisbane, Queensland, on board HMAT A55 *Kyarra* on 16 August 1915. Unit embarked from Adelaide, South Australia, on board HMAT A15 *Star Of England* on 21 September 1915. Wounded in action Belgium 31 July 1917 GSW right leg. Admitted hospital Wandsworth London 4 August 1917. Returned to Base Depot France from wounded 30 May 1918. Returned to Australia 28 March 1919. Died 7 November 1962. Buried Mt Gravatt Cemetery, Brisbane, Qld.
