

Enlisted at: Rockhampton, Qld on 20 October 1916 aged 20 years 4 months

Next-of-kin was father, Edwin Woodruff, Raglan, NC Line, Queensland.

On enlistment he was 5 ft 10 inches and weighed 140 lbs. His chest measurement was 35 inches. His occupation was labourer, Raglan, Qld. Unit embarked from Sydney, New South Wales, on board HMAT A72 *Beltana* on 25 November 1916. Sick to hospital influenza 21 February 1917. Wounded in action 6 October 1917. Rejoined battalion 26 January 1918. Wounded in action 2<sup>nd</sup> occasion 4 July 1918 GSW left groin. Hospital Rouen. Transferred to England 12 August 1918. Returned to Australia 23 March 1919.
