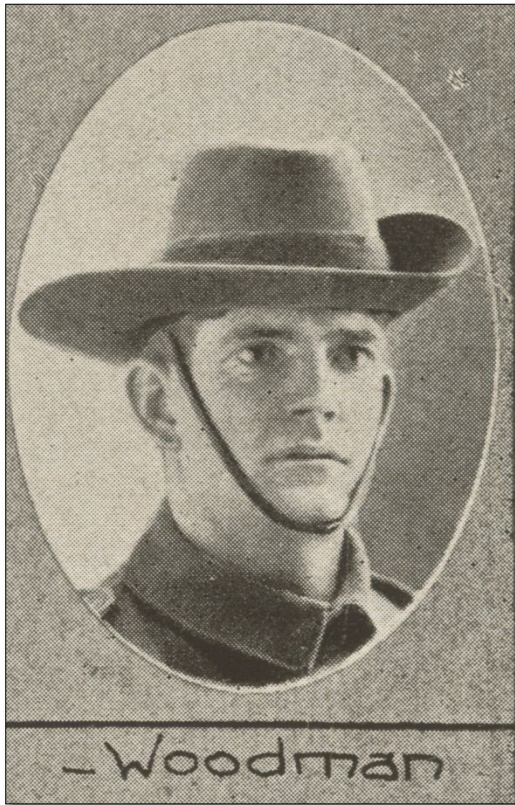


WOODMAN, Walter Robert

Place of Birth: Childers, Queensland

Date of Birth: 8 October 1887

Enlisted at: Gladstone, Queensland on 14 January 1915, aged 27 years 4 months.

Next-of-kin was father, Walter William Woodman, Mount Larcom, Queensland.

On enlistment he was 6 ft 2.5 inches and weighed 190 lbs. His chest measurement was 36-38 inches. His occupation was farmer. Previously in E Company, Wide Bay Regiment for 3.5 years. Unit embarked from Brisbane, Queensland, on board HMAT A48 *Seang Bee* on 13 February 1915. Served

Gallipoli. Then France. Wounded in action GSW right wrist, 5 April 1918.
Returned to Australia 14 December 1918. Date of death 8 May 1959. Mt
Thompson Crematorium, Brisbane, Qld.
