
## **WOODMAN, Walter Robert**

months.

Next-of-kin was father, Walter William Woodman, Mount Larcom, Queensland.

On enlistment he was 6 ft 2.5 inches and weighed 190 lbs. His chest measurement was 36-38 inches. His occupation was farmer. Previously in E Company, Wide Bay Regiment for 3.5 years. Unit embarked from Brisbane, Queensland, on board HMAT A48 Seang Bee on 13 February 1915. Served

Gallipoli. Then France. Wounded in action GSW right wrist, 5 April 1918. Returned to Australia 14 December 1918. Date of death 8 May 1959. Mt Thompson Crematorium, Brisbane, Qld.
