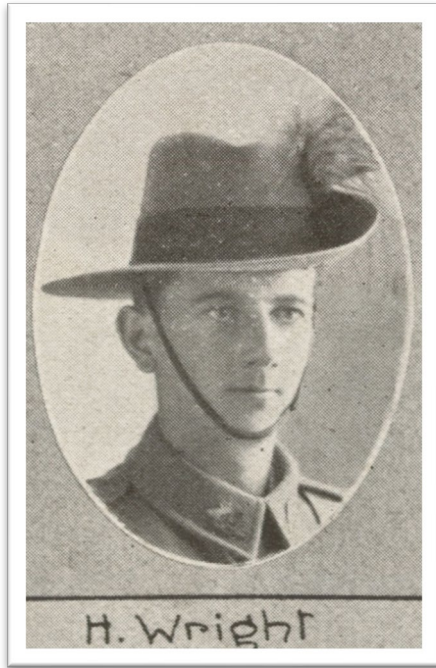


## WRIGHT, Harry

Unit: 5<sup>th</sup> Light Horse Regiment, 12<sup>th</sup> Reinforcement

Place of Birth: Calliope, Queensland.

Date of Birth: 21 August 1885

Enlisted at Enoggera, Queensland on 1 July 1915, aged 29 years

Next-of-kin was mother, Mary Jane WRIGHT (nee HEWITT), Calliope via Gladstone, Qld. Father, George Wright.

On enlistment he was 5 ft 9 inches and weighed 10 stone 3 lbs. His chest measurement was 34-37 inches. His occupation was labourer. Unit embarked from Sydney, New South Wales, on board HMAA A23 *Suffolk* on 30 November 1915. Served Egypt. Returned to Australia 28 June 1919.
