Taken on strength France 23 November 1916. Returned to Australia 12 April 1919.

NB. Prior to enlistment on 23 August 1915, the Oath of Allegiance was administered by Police Magistrate, James Bracewell to John David Anton Markstedt, as he was volunteering for service at the front and requesting that the Naturalisation be expedited.
