- 8. All entries must be ready for display with 'D' rings attached, 10cm from the top for larger works and 5cm for smaller works.
- 9. All works entered in the *Golding Showcase* must remain in the exhibition until the exhibition end date. Gladstone Regional Art Gallery and Museum will not approve removal of any works during the exhibition.
