- 4. Collaborative works may be included but no more than two works by any one participant is to be submitted.
- 5. No size limits apply; however works must be able to be handled safely by two people.
- 6. Works in all media and techniques are encouraged, including digital work.
- 7. Artworks may be photographed and reproduced for publicity, archive or catalogue purposes associated with the *Golding Showcase*.
- 8. Every care will be taken when handling and exhibiting artworks, but no liability will be accepted for loss or damage.
- 9. All entries must be ready for display with 'D' rings attached, 10cm from the top for larger works and 5cm for smaller works.
- 10. All works entered in the *Golding Showcase* must remain in the exhibition until the exhibition end date. Gladstone Regional Art Gallery and Museum will not approve removal of any works during the exhibition.
