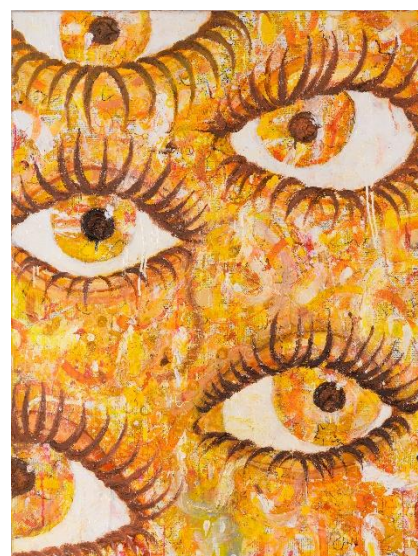

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The *Golding Showcase* is an exhibition of selected works, by artists that are between 15 and 18 years of age and reside in the Port Curtis (Gladstone) and Callide Valley areas.
2. Submissions must be the original work of the participant and created within the 12 months prior to the submission.
3. The Curator's decision of the winner of the Curator's prize is not-negotiable, and no correspondence will be entered into.
4. Collaborative works may be included but no more than two works by any one participant is to be submitted.
5. Works must be able to be handled safely by two people. Maximum size for work required to be on a plinth is 400mm x 400mm.
6. Works in all media and techniques are encouraged, including digital work. Works requiring batteries must be accompanied by enough batteries to last the duration of the exhibition.
7. Artworks may be photographed and reproduced for publicity, archive or catalogue purposes associated with the *Golding Showcase*.
8. Every care will be taken when handling and exhibiting artworks, but no liability will be accepted for loss or damage.
9. All entries must be ready for display with 'D' rings attached, 10cm from the top for larger works and 5cm for smaller works.
10. All works entered in the *Golding Showcase* must remain in the exhibition until the exhibition end date. Gladstone Regional Art Gallery and Museum will not approve removal of any works during the exhibition.

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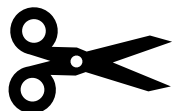
