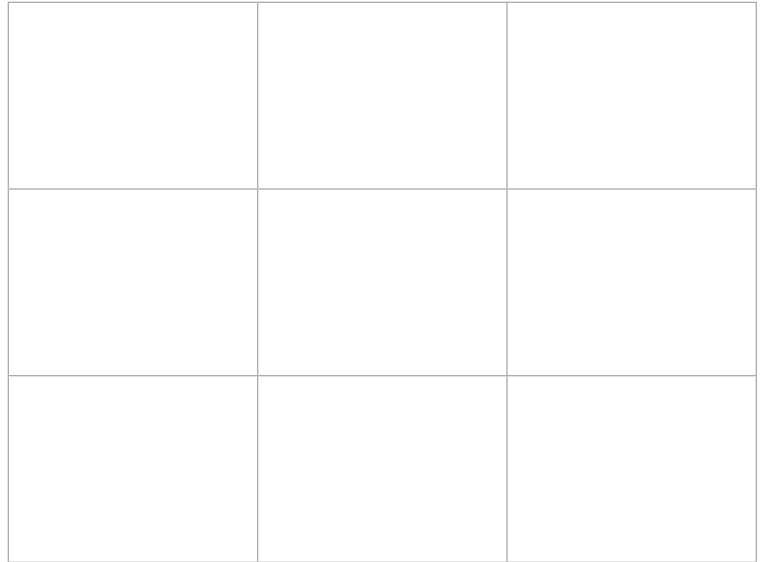
- 3 Find a photo taken before 1950. Why do you think it looks different from modern photos?

- 4 Rule of Thirds  
What is the meaning of rule of thirds?

When taking a photograph, the artist can use the Rule of Thirds to create an attractive image. This is when an image is divided into thirds *vertically* and *horizontally* like a tic- tac-toe grid.

The photographer then uses these lines to decide where to place the subject. This is a way to draw the viewer's eye around the image. When the strongest elements are along the lines or at an intersection it makes a more interesting photograph.
